We are delighted that Guildford has been allocated the following match:

SURREY CCC v NOTTINGHAMSHIRE CCC
(Royal London One-Day Cup)
on Tuesday, 27th July.

Play starts at 11.00 am and the gates open at 9.30 am.

Subject to any change announced by the Government, normal arrangements will apply to this match, with no special restrictions on spectators.

How do I get tickets?

Tickets are available from Surrey CCC in advance online from:

Tickets purchased in advance cost £15 per day for adults (U-16 juniors who are accompanied by an adult pay £1). Tickets are on sale from 19th March.

You are recommended to purchase tickets in advance in case the match sells out. If there is space, tickets will be available for purchase on the day at the gate. Check the Surrey CCC website for updates: www.kiaoval.com.

If Tickets are available for purchase on the day at the gate, they will cost £20 for adults (£1 for U-16 juniors). Note that that cash only is taken at the gate – no cards.

Members of Surrey CCC are entitled to free admission upon production of their 2021 Membership Card. Members may use their Guest Vouchers. Guildford Cricket Club Members are also entitled to free admission upon production of their 2021 Membership Card.

Bag search at the entry gate

Stewards may conduct a search at the entrance gates of all bags carried by spectators.

Alcohol

A maximum of four 500ml cans of beer/lager or a 750ml plastic bottle of wine per person may be brought into the Ground. No further alcohol will be permitted on any subsequent re-admission.

Where may I sit?

All seating is unreserved, except for the Corporate Marquees and one stand reserved for Surrey

members. It's best to arrive early to choose where you wish to sit. You may bring your own chairs if you so wish, though it is not necessary to do so.

May I park my car in the ground?

No. The Pavilion car park is closed. Cars are parked on the grass at the Railway End of the ground, but spaces are allocated only to players, match officials and guests of hirers the corporate hospitality tents. We will make every effort to allow parking at the Railway End by cars with a Blue Badge.

If you do not have a car park pass or a Blue Badge, you will not be able to park inside the ground.

Public car parking

Members of the public may use the Student Car at **Guildford College** is available on a first-come-first-served basis on the day of the match. Guildford College is at Stoke Road GU1 1EZ (less than 10 minutes' walk from The Sports Ground).

Information on Guildford Borough public car parks is at www.guildford.gov.uk/parkandride, with the nearest being at **Mary Road GU1 4QU**. You may also use the park and ride at Guildford Spectrum at Parkway (GU1 1UP), which is nearby.

Guildford Cricket Club is an easy walk from Guildford main railway station and the bus station.

May I buy food and drink at the Festival?

Volunteers from Guildford Cricket Club operate a combined Public Refreshment Tent and Beer Tent. This is located at the Railway End in the marquee section closest to the Woodbridge Road.

All profits from the Refreshment & Beer Tent go towards junior cricket at Guildford CC..

Are there facilities for Surrey CCC members?

Yes. There is a stand at the Railway End of The Sports Ground and a marquee with seating reserved for Surrey CCC Members. These are on the Dapdune Wharf side of the ground, furthest from the Woodbridge Road
